Duties and Responsibilities:	<p>Assist the Child Care Coordinator, in providing appropriate child care services and activities for children in art, music, literature, culture, and play.</p> <p>Assist in promoting and supervising the healthy emotional, social, intellectual, and physical development of each child.</p> <p>Assist in the upkeep of the Child Care Center and all equipment and materials. Eat any meals with children and assist in development of good nutrition habits and table manners.</p> <p>Help children establish good habits of toileting and personal hygiene and cleanliness.</p> <p>Assist in supervising all activities to insure safety of each child at all times.</p> <p>Must be able to lift 50 lbs.</p> <p>Maintain prompt hours; notify Child Care Coordinator in the event of illness or upcoming absence (ahead of time).</p> <p>Maintain neat and clean appearance.</p> <p>Work with all other staff members in a cooperative manner.</p> <p>Attend and participate in staff meetings.</p> <p>Must attend trainings as designated by the Child Care Coordinator.</p> <p>Work toward attainment of Child Development Associate Certification (CDA) and First Aid/CPR certification.</p> <p>Must make referrals as necessary pertaining to children and families.</p> <p>Must be able to work evenings and weekends as needed.</p> <p>Is bound by mandatory reporting requirements as determined by Tribal, State, and Federal Law.</p> <p>Other duties as assigned by supervisor.</p>
Qualifications:	<p>Must have High School Diploma or GED.</p> <p>Must have a combination of six month or equivalent of education/training and child care experience.</p>

CPR and First Aid certification preferred, or must obtain within 3 months of date of hire. CDA will be required to be completed within 16 months.
