



The full student code of conduct is found on pages 13-14 of the Student Handbook. A summary of the points that apply most directly to student travel is provided below. By signing this form, a student agrees to follow the Code of Conduct.

While participating in college activities, including college sponsored travel off-campus, students will:

- Support and carry out the purpose of the activity
- Cooperate with other members of the travel group, assisting them when needed
- Comply with directives of college officials, specifically including faculty or administrators carrying out their duties
- Follow college policies, local ordinances, and state or federal laws
- Refrain from using or carrying alcohol, drugs, or controlled substances except for their own prescribed medications
- Use tobacco only for ceremonial purposes or in designated smoking areas
- Use college, public, and private property appropriately, avoiding damage
- Refrain from using or carrying a weapon, unless authorized by the college
- Maintain college property and data securely
- Uphold academic integrity
- Provide only truthful and accurate information to college personnel or to officials when needed for travel
- To the best of their ability, bring honor to the college by their behavior.
